CURRENT SITUATION

Final The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to a possible vegetation fire near the Carlson's Dog Park. Upon arrival we found about a 50 by 50 area of vegetation on fire on the side of Mt. Rubidoux off of Mission Inn Blvd. at the bridge. Crews were assigned to extinguish and mitigate the incident. RPD was requested to stop traffic in both direction on Mission Inn at the Bridge. They were also assigned to evacuate MT Rubidoux walking trail as the fire was headed that way. Air 1 was requested to assist with the evacuations. There was a possible suspect in the area, however the lead turned out not to be credible. After the fire investigators spoke to him. The cause of the fire was human in nature but undetermined on the exact cause. The total acreage was confirmed via GPS at 3.1 acres. The fire was under control in approximately 45 minutes. Crews continue to mop up the area. Once the fire was 100% contained we picked up our hose and cleared the call. No firefighter were injured during this incident.
