### CURRENT SITUATION

The City of Riverside Fire Department responded to a report of smoke coming from a neighbor's house. The first arriving engine company captain reported smoke showing from a working fire. Initially thought to be an attic fire, the crew performing fire attack located and extinguished a fire in the kitchen. There was very little fire extension, but there is extensive smoke damage throughout the house. No one was home when the fire started, but three cats were located while searching the house. Only one was revived successfully. An investigation confirmed that the fire started in the kitchen and was due to an electrical issue. The displaced owner made private arrangements for temporary housing. No civilians or firefighters were injured during the course of this incident. A \$100 California Fire Foundation SAVE Card was issued to the homeowner.
