**SUBJECT: Flag Guidon Etiquette**

**POLICY:**

Both Operations and Training must take full responsibility for their Flag and Guidon. This means maintenance and known location at all times; treat your Flag and Guidon just as you would the U.S. Flag. It is the responsibility of each group to have their Flag out and dressed on their stand prior to attendance (1745), unless weather has any potential in damaging the flag it is to stay inside the classroom the remainder of the meeting unless told otherwise by a Training Officer or Advisor. Once attendance is done and PT has started, each flag has the potential to be obtained by opposing groups the remainder of the night. During anytime the Flag or Guidon is in its stand it is deemed safe. In the event a groups Flag or Guidon is obtained by the opposing group, it is to be worked out in a reasonable manner between opposing groups keeping a positive attitude and being reasonable. Outside of the Training Tower such as any event or ceremony it is the responsibility of the Training Officers to transport and have their group Flag and Guidon present.
