

Becoming a Heritage House volunteer is a great way to help preserve and share Riverside's Victorian history with others! By joining today, you will be a part of a great team of dedicated volunteers who have shared their time and talents for over 30 years!

HOUSE TOURS

Lead tours for adults and children, sharing with them your enthusiasm and knowledge of the house and Riverside's Victorian history.

SCHOOL PROGRAMS AND TOURS

Lead tours or assist with hands-on activities specifically designed for school groups, introducing them to what life in Riverside was like in the 1890s.

GARDEN TEAS

Help organize and set up lovely garden teas. Garden Tea volunteers have the opportunity to make and serve homemade treats and tea.

MUSEUM GIFT SHOP

Assist with gift shop sales while welcoming visitors. The shop features Victorian goods, books, and more.

GARDEN PROJECTS

Learn about heirloom and Victorian-era plants and help maintain the gardens by participating in a range of special garden projects led by a team of Master Gardeners and landscape designers.

SECRETARIAL AND COMPUTER

Assist with maintaining training materials, data entry, mailings, and other important tasks.

SPECIAL EVENTS AND OTHER ACTIVITIES
