On February 27, 2010, the City of Riverside opened the doors to the new La Sierra Senior Center and refurbished Community Center.

The new Senior Center currently provides activities for adults 55 years and older, which include life-long learning classes such as basic computer, Spanish, and book club discussion groups in the computer lab and library. A wide variety of interactive social activities are offered at the new facility. The banquet room with full service kitchen hosted a Senior Fashion Show, Intergenerational Senior Citizen Prom, the Breakfast Club and monthly holiday luncheons. A number of agencies such as the Riverside County Office on Aging and Riverside Medical Foundation provide social services at the new facility, which include caregiver classes, legal assistance, and health insurance counseling services.

The Senior Center hosts a 55 and beyond excursion program in which seniors have enjoyed a number of day trips to Newport Beach, San Diego, Balboa Park and Huntington Library.

The renovated Community Center's reception area, offices and meeting room have been a perfect location for the all new Youth Sports and Cheer Summer Camp, Teen Club, Youth Cheer Program and a place for community groups like the La Sierra Arlanza Neighborhood Community Group to meet.
