WITNESSITH; That for and in consideration of the sum of five and no/dollars \$5.00) dollars in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part does by these presents remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to her heirs and assigns forever, all that certain lot or parcel of land siuate in the city of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and bounded and particularly described as follows; to-wit:

All that portion of the right of way of the lower Canal of the Riverside Water Company in lot thirteen (13) block seventeen (17) of the lands of the Riverside Land and Irrigation Company, as shown by map recorded in office of the County recorder of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, in book 1 of maps, at page 70 thereof, lying Southerly and Easterly of the following described line, beginning at a point on the Southerly line of the said lot thirteen (13) distant North 56° East, 263.5 feet, from the Southerwesterly corner of said lot (13), Thence North 29°21' West, 60 feet; thence North 140°38' West 55 ft. thence North 3°38' West 65 feet, Thence North 17°21' East, 77.4 feet, thence North 21°30' East, 340.88 feet; thence South 34° East, to a point on the Northeasterly line of said lot (13) distant North 34° West, 388.46 feet from the Southeasterly corner of said lot 13.
