THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation for and in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 (\$1.00) dollars, to it in hand paid, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto JOHN W. MILLER and FLOSSIE MILLER, husband and wife, as joint tenants, with the right of survivorship all that certain real property situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The Southeasterly one half of the abandoned right of way of the lower canal of the Riverside Water Company, lying westerly of and adjoining Lot 6 of Files Subdivision No. 4, as shown by map of record in Book 6 of Maps, page 60, Riverside County Records, and one half of the abandoned right of way of the said canal lying northwesterly of that portion of Arroyo Vista Avenue, now abandoned, lying northerly and westerly of the northwesterly line of Lot 7, Files Subdivision No. 4.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said City of Riverside has by resolution caused this deed to be signed by its Mayor and attested by its City Clerk and its corporate seal thereto affixed this 21st day of January, 1932.
