QUITCLAIM DEED

The City of Riverside, a municipal corporation for and in consideration of the sum of One no/100 (\$1.00) dollars, to it in hand paid, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto Gertrude E. Wood, all that certain real property situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land of the uniform width of forty (40) feet, lying, Westerly of and adjacent to Lot 1, Block 48, Arlington Heights, as shown by map recorded in Book 11 of Maps, page 20 and 21, Records of San Bernardino County, California, said strip of land being a portion of the Easterly half of St. Lawrence Street, now abandoned:
