

## RESOLUTION NO. 1905 (NEW SERIES)

(Resolution declaring that Closing up and Vacating Portion of Hawarden Drive has been completed).

Whereas, the Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 2nd day of August, 1932, pass its resolution No. 1904 (New Series) Ordering the work of closing up and vacating that portion of Hawarden Drive in said City hereinafter described, as contemplated by resolution of intention No. 1902 (New Series); and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Hawarden Drive has been done and completed:

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council hereby determines that that portion of Hawarden Drive in said City hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

The portion of Hawarden Drive in said City hereinabove referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the southeasterly corner of that certain parcel of land conveyed to the Washington Heights Water Pumping Company by deed recorded in Book 411 of Deeds, Page 29, Records of Riverside County, California; thence on a line bearing North  $82^{\circ} 53'$  East, a distance of 41.60 feet to the true point of beginning of the parcel of land to be described; thence continuing on a line bearing North  $81^{\circ} 53'$  East, a distance of 17.87 feet to a point; thence Northeasterly on a curve, tangent to the last described line, concave to the Northwest, with a radius of 190 feet, through an angle of  $28^{\circ} 04' 30''$ , a distance of 93.10 feet to a point; thence on a line bearing north  $72^{\circ} 39'$  East, a distance of 33.63 feet to a point; thence on a line bearing north  $46^{\circ} 27'$  East, a distance of 52.19 feet to a point; thence on a line bearing south  $31^{\circ} 47'$  West, a distance of 1.79 feet to a point; thence on a curve tangent to the last described line, concave to the northwest, with a radius of 210 feet, through an angle of  $51^{\circ} 06'$  a distance of 187.29 feet; thence on a line, tangent to the last described curve, bearing south  $82^{\circ} 53'$  West, a distance of 64.76 feet to a point; thence

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Northeasterly on a direct line to the true point of beginning.
