Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Crown Street in said City has been completed, and that the same is closed up and vacated.

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 19th. day of January, 1926, pass its Resolution No. 861 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Crown Street in said City hereinafter described as contemplated by Resolution of intention No. 840 (New Series) and

Whereas, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Crown Street has been done and completed.

Now, therefore be<sup>v</sup> resolved, that the common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that the portion of Crown Street in said City herein after described is closed up and vacated as a Public Street of said City.

The portion of Crown Street hereinbefore referred to and affected by this Resolution described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Crown Street lying Northerly of a line described as follows; beginning at the most Southeasterly corner of lot 52 Victoria Park Addition as recorded in book 7 page 18. records of Riverside County, California; thence Northeasterly to the most Southwesterly corner of lot 61, said Victoria Park addition, thence N. 88°51' E. 115.16 feet; thence Southeasterly to the Most Westerly corner of lot 103 of said Victoria, Park Tract.
