

## RESOLUTION NO. 920 (NEW SERIES)

Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Spring Street in said City has been completed and that the same is closed up and vacated.

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 4th day of May, 1926, pass its resolution No. 909 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Spring Street in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 889 (New Series) and

Whereas, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Spring Street has been done and completed.

Now, Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the Common Council of the City of Riverside, hereby declares that the portion of Spring Street in said City herein after described is closed up and vacated as a public street of said City.

The portion of Spring Street hereinbefore referred to and affected by this Resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

The northerly 77.45 feet of Spring Street, formerly known as Grove Avenue, and described as that portion of Grove Avenue, as shown on the Map of Rockledge, Recorded in Book 4, of Maps, at page 56, records of Riverside County, California, to-wit: Beginning at the Northeast corner of Block 3 of said Rockledge, thence S. 00° 07' E. 86.9 feet to the true point of beginning; thence S. 00° 07' E. 77.45 feet along the west line of said Grove Avenue to a point; thence N. 89° 53' E. 60 feet to a point; thence N. 00° 07' W. 75.55 feet to a point; thence N. 86° 33' W. 60.04 feet to the point of beginning.
