

RESOLUTION NO. 970 (NEW SERIES)

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Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside declaring that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Gibson Street and a portion of Dufferin Avenue in said City of Riverside has been completed and that the same are closed up and vacated.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 4th day of May, 1926, pass its Resolution No. 907 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Gibson Street and a portion of Dufferin Avenue in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Reslution of Intention No. 884 (New Series) and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portions of Gibson Street and Dufferin Avenue has been done and completed;

NOW THEREFORE, be it Resolved that the Common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that the portions of Gibson Street and Dufferin Avenue hereinafter described are closed up and vacated as public streets of said City.

The portions of Gibson Street and Dufferin Avenue hereinbefore referred to and affected by this Resolution are described as follows, to-wit:

That portion of Gibson Street from the Easterly line of Cleveland Avenue to the R. of W. of the Gage Canal as shown on Map of Arlington Heights, as recorded in Book 11 of Maps, page 20 et seq., records of San Bernardino County, State of California, saving and excepting the crossing of Dufferin Avenue. And also of that portion of Dufferin Avenue as shown on a map recorded as part of a deed for a road in lieu of the said portion of Dufferin Avenue to be abandoned,

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said deed and map recorded in Book 544 of Deeds, at page 479 et seq., records of Riverside County, State of California; and more particularly described as follows; to-wit: Beginning at a point in the center line of Dufferin Avenue 1069.08 feet N. 56° 00' E from the intersection of the center line of Dufferin Avenue and Van Buren Street, said point being also in the center line of a road Sixty (60) feet wide, bearing S. 87° 26' E. to the right, thence N. 56° 00' E. 941.9 feet along the center line of said Dufferin Avenue to a point, said point being also in the center line of the aforesaid 60 foot road and entering N. 16° 44' E. from the right, reserving and excepting therefrom any portion of the 60 foot road herein above mentioned.

Albert Mills, the duly elected, qualified and acting clerk of the City of Riverside, California, do hereby certify that the foregoing Resolution was duly and regularly introduced and adopted by the Common Council of the City of Riverside, at its meeting held on the 20th day of July 1926, by the following vote:
