Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside declaring the work of closing up and vacating of ^{of} Arlington Avenue in said City has been completed and that the same is closed up and vacated.

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 29th day of June, 1926, pass its Resolution of No. 951 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Houghton Avenue in said City, hereinafter described as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 917 (New Series), and

Whereas, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Houghton Avenue has been done and completed.

Now therefore, Be it resolved, that the Common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that the portion of Houghton Avenue in said City hereinafter described is closed up and vacated as a public street in said City.

The portion of Houghton Avenue hereinafter referred to and affected by this Resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Houghton Avenue as shown on map of Lett's Subdivision recorded on page 95 in Book 8 of Maps, San Bernardino County Records, lying Southeasterly of a line parallel to and 8 feet distant Southeast-erly from the Southeasterly line of Market Street as shown on above mentioned map of Letts Re-subdivision.
