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RESOLUTION NO. 1080 (NEW SERIES)

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE DECLARING THAT THE WORK OF CLOSING UP AND VACATING A PORTION OF CRIDGE STREET IN SAID CITY HAS BEEN COMPLETED AND THAT THE SAME IS CLOSED UP AND VACATED.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 15th day of March, 1927, pass its Resolution No. 1077 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Cridge Street in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1060 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Cridge Street has been done and completed.

NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Common Council of the City of Riverside hereby declares that that certain portion of Cridge Street in said City, hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

The portion of Cridge Street referred to and affected by this resolution is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the Southeasterly corner of Lot 10 as shown on Map of Carlton Place as recorded in Book 3 of Maps, page 79, Records of Riverside County, California; thence easterly along the northerly line of said Cridge Street to the westerly line of High Street; thence southerly along the westerly line of High Street to the southerly line of said Cridge Street; thence westerly along the southerly line of said Cridge Street to a point that is at right angles to southeasterly corner of said Lot 10; thence northerly at right angles to the westerly line of said Cridge Street to the point of beginning.
