

## RESOLUTION NO. 1371 (NEW SERIES)

BK. 767 - P. 583

Resolution of the Common Council of the City of Riverside, declaring that the work of closing up and vacating that portion of Grove Avenue lying between the Southerly line of Thirteenth Street, and a line parallel with and 9 feet Northerly of the Northerly line of Fourteenth Street. Also the Alley between Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 and Lots 11 12, 13 and 14 in Block 12, Santa Fe Tract, as recorded in Book 6 of Maps, page 14, records of San Bernardino County, California, in said City, has been completed and that the same is Closed up and Vacated.

Whereas, the Common Council of the City of Riverside did on the 29th day of May, 1928, pass its Resolution No. 1362 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating that portion of Grove Avenue in said City and the alley adjoining thereon, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1333 (New Series) and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Common Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Grove Avenue and the alley adjoining thereon has been done and completed.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Common Council hereby determines that that portion of Grove Avenue in said City and the alley adjoining thereon, hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

That portion of Grove Avenue affected by this Resolution is particularly described as follows:
