All that portion of the abandoned right of way of the Riverside Water Company's Lower Canal lying between Indiana Avenue and Van Buren Street, being 16.5 feet in width and adjoining Lot 28, Block 26 of the Village of Arlington as shown by Map recorded in Book 1 of Maps, page 62, Record of San Bernardino County, California.
