THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation for and in consideration of the sum of \$5.00 to it in hand paid, does hereby remise, release and forever quitclaim unto FRANK P. TROTTA all that certain real property situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The Northerly one half of the abandoned portion of Fifteenth Street lying between the right of way of the Union Pacific Railroad Company and the right of way of the Riverside Water Company for Canal purposes adjoining a portion of Lot 1 of the lands of the Southern California Colony Association.
