

RESOLUTION NO. 1673 (NEW SERIES)
 (RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT CLOSING UP AND
 VACATING HAS BEEN COMPLETED)
 PORTION OF AURORA DRIVE

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WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 4th. day of March 1930, pass its Resolution No. 1670 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating that portion of Aurora Drive in said City hereinafter described as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1661 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Aurora Drive has been done and completed;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council hereby determine that that portion of Aurora Drive in said City hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

The portion of Aurora Drive in said City herein above referred to is described as follows. to-wit:

Commencing at the intersection of the Northeasterly line of Lot 19, Beacon Heights as recorded in Book 15 of Maps, page 84, Records of Riverside County, California, and the Northwesterly line of Aurora Drive as shown on the map of said Beacon Heights said point being the point of beginning of the parcel to be described; thence Southeasterly along the Southeasterly production of the Northeasterly line of said Lot 19, a distance of 7.03 to a point; thence Southwesterly along the arc of a curve with a radius of 236.11 feet thru an angle of 2°10' a distance of 8.93 feet to a point; thence on a line, tangent to the last described curve, bearing South 21°38' West, a distance of 10 feet to a point; thence Southwesterly along the arc of a curve with a radius of 38.85 feet thru an angle of 55°00' a distance of-

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37.29 feet to a point; thence on a line tangent to the last described curve, bearing South 76°39' West a distance of 12.80 feet to a point; thence Southwesterly along the arc of a curve, tangent to the last described line, with a radius of 600 feet thru an angle of 6°47' a distance of 71.03 feet to a point; thence on a line tangent to the last described curve, bearing South 69°51' West, a distance of 23.37 feet to a point; thence Southwesterly along the arc of a curve with a radius of 184.07 feet thru an angle of 20°00' a distance of 64.25 feet to a point; thence continuing Southwesterly along the arc of a curve, reverse to the last described curve with a radius of 63.15 feet thru an angle of 38°-20' a distance of 42.25 feet to a point; thence on a line tangent to the last described curve, bearing South 88° 11' West to its intersection with the Northwesterly line of Aurora Drive as shown on Map of Beacon Heights, recorded in Book 15 of Maps, page 84, Records of Riverside County, California, thence Northeasterly along the Northeasterly line of said Aurora Drive to the point of beginning.
