THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation, for and in consideration of the sum of Five dollars (\$5.00) to it in hand paid, does hereby, remise, release, and forever quitclaim unto VIDA C. HALLIBURTON, married woman, all that certain real property situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land of the uniform width of 33 feet and being all that portion of the abandoned right-of-way of the lower canal of the Riverside Water Company lying within the Northeasterly rectangular one half of lot 6, in Block 22 of the lands of Riverside Land and Irrigating Company, as shown by map thereof recorded in book 1 of maps, at page 70, Records of San Bernardino County, California; also a strip of land of the uniform width of 16½ feet and being that portion of the abandoned right-of-way of the lower canal of the Riverside Water Company, lying Southerly of the center line in the Southwesterly rectangular one half of lots 7 and 10 of said Block 22.
