

RESOLUTION NO. 3328 (NEW SERIES)

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING A DEED QUITCLAIMING TO EARL W. PORTER A CERTAIN RIGHT-OF-WAY.

RESOLVED, that the deed dated October 13, 1939, quitclaiming to Earl W. Porter all of that portion of an easement and right-of-way for electric pole lines, with appurtenances, over and across a portion of Lot 7, of Pachappa Knolls, heretofore granted to the City of Riverside by said Earl W. Porter, as evidenced by deed of record in Book 95, page 554, of Official Records of Riverside County, California, which easement and right-of-way is more particularly described as follows; to-wit:

Commencing at a point 164 feet North 25° 23' East from the Northeasterly corner of Lot 7 of Pachappa Knolls, as shown by plat recorded in Book 17, page 29 of Maps, records of said Riverside County; thence North 61° 30' West to a point in the westerly line of Pachappa Drive, as the same is now constituted at that point, which is the point of beginning of this description; thence North 61° 30' West to the end of that course, as shown by plat attached to and recorded with the grant of the right of way recorded in said Book 95, page 554 of Official Records; thence South 71° 05' West to the point of intersection with the Northerly line of a ten foot easement granted for similar purposes to the City of Riverside by Earl W. Porter and Earle Tarr Porter, his wife, by deed dated September 18, 1939, and recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.


