

RESOLUTION NO. 1812 (NEW SERIES)

Resolution Declaring that Closing up and vacating has been completed. Portion of Buena Vista Avenue.

WHEREAS, the Common Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 24th day of March, 1931, pass its Resolution No. 1808 (New Series) ordering that work of closing up and vacating that portion of Buena Vista Avenue in said City hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 1798 (New Series) and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Buena Vista Avenue has been done and completed:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council hereby determines that that portion of Buena Vista Avenue in said City hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

The portion of Buena Vista Avenue in said City hereinabove referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

Beginning at the intersection of the Westerly line of Rubidoux Drive and the Northeasterly line of Buena Vista Avenue which is the most Southerly corner of Lot 5, Block 23, Rubidoux Heights, recorded in Book 4 of Maps, page 80, Records of Riverside County, thence North $31^{\circ} 43' 30''$ West, a distance of 84.16 feet to the point of beginning of the parcel of land to be described; thence North $31^{\circ} 43' 30''$ West a distance of 79.19 feet to a point, thence North $60^{\circ} 35'$ West, a distance of 30.5 feet to a point, thence South $39^{\circ} 40' 10''$ East, a distance of 105.94 feet to the point of beginning.
