

RESOLUTION NO. 3049 (NEW SERIES)

*BK. 314 - P. 33*RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT CLOSING UP AND VACATING
HAS BEEN COMPLETED
PORTION OF PLINY STREET

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 5th day of January, 1937 pass its Resolution No. 3048 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating that portion of Pliny Street in said City hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 3043 (New Series); and

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Pliny Street has been done and completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council hereby determines that that portion of Pliny Street in said City hereinafter described, is closed and vacated.

The portion of Pliny Street in said City hereinabove referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Pliny Street lying between the Northwesterly line of Evans Street as extended and the Southeasterly line of the right of way of the Atchison and Topeka Railway Company, as shown by map on file in the office of the County Recorder of the County of San Bernardino, State of California, in Book 9 at page 21 thereof;

I, G. Albert Mills, the City Clerk of the City of Riverside, California, hereby certify that the foregoing resolution was duly and regularly introduced and adopted by the Council of said City of Riverside, at its meeting held on the 12th day of January, ¹⁹³⁷ 1917, by the following vote:
