

RESOLUTION NO. 3102

(NEW SERIES)

Declaring that the Closing up and Vacating of a portion of Prospect Avenue has been completed.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, did, on the 28th day of September, 1937, pass its Resolution No. 3099 (New Series), ordering the work of closing up and vacating of a portion of Prospect Avenue in said City hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 3090 (New Series): and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating of that portion of Prospect Avenue has been done and completed:

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved, that said Council hereby declares that that certain portion of Prospect Avenue, hereinafter described, is closed and vacated,

That portion of Prospect Avenue hereinabove referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

The Southerly three ⁷⁷(3) of Prospect Avenue, lying immediately Northerly of the Westerly 98 feet of the Easterly 193 feet of Lot 5 of Prospect Place.
