Upon motion of Supervisor Hammer seconded
ed by Supervisor Kumbell and duly carried
the following resolution was adopted:
Resolved: That, Whereas, Frank S. Johnson &
have this day filed their petition praying
that the Board close certain streets in
Supervisor, District No. 1, and it appearing to
the Board that said streets have never
been used as public highways, and that
public convenience does not require their
use as such, it is therefore resolved, that
said petition be granted and the following
streets are hereby vacated and closed:
General street from intersection of Magnolia
Avenue to Santa Fe Railroad; Grant street
from intersection of Magnolia Ave to Santa
Fe Railroad; Lincoln street from Magnolia
Avenue, northerly, to its present termination;
Filmore street, from Magnolia Avenue to
California Avenue; Gaylor street to Califor-
nia Avenue; and California Avenue from
the northwesterly corner of Block 50 to the north-
easterly corner of Block 47, as per map of the
Reverend Land Company
