

RESOLUTION NO. 3241 (NEW SERIES)

RESOLUTION DECLARING THAT THE CLOSING UP AND VACATING OF A PORTION OF ELEVENTH STREET HAS BEEN COMPLETED.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside did on the 27th day of December, 1938, pass its Resolution No. 3235 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Eleventh Street in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 3222 (New Series); and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported to said Council that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Eleventh Street has been done and completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council hereby determines that that portion of Eleventh Street in said City, hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated;

The portion of Eleventh Street in said City hereinabove referred to is described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Eleventh Street lying between the Easterly line of Vine Street and the Westerly line of Olive Street;

Reserving a right-of-way for storm water drain 7.5 feet on either side of the following described center line:

Beginning at a point on the Westerly line of Olive Street, 11.5 feet north of the southwest corner of Eleventh and Olive Streets; thence Westerly parallel to Eleventh Street to the Easterly line of Vine Street.
