RESOLUTION NO. 3449

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING A FINDING THAT A PORTION OF OLIVE STREET IS UNNECESSARY FOR PRESENT AND PROSPECTIVE PUBLIC STREET PURPOSES; RESERVING TO THE CITY EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY PROVIDED FOR IN SECTION 8330 OF THE STRAITS AND HIGHWAYS CODE; AND MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING SAID PORTION OF OLIVE STREET.

WHEREAS, on the 29th day of July, 1952, Ordinance No. 1771 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate a portion of a street commonly known as Olive Street, as shown on a certain map on file with the City Clerk of Riverside, California; and,

WHEREAS, it was set forth in said Ordinance that the said portion of Olive Street sought to be vacated was located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and more particularly described as follows:

That portion of Olive Street between the southerly line of Tenth Street and the northerly line of Twelfth Street, and including all of its intersection with Eleventh Street, as shown on map of Town of Riverside recorded in Map Book 7, page 17, Records of San Bernardino County, California; said Olive Street adjacent easterly of Block 10, Range 1, and Block 11, Range 1, of said Town of Riverside; AND ERECTING AND RESERVING the easements and rights of way hereinafter set forth;

and, WHEREAS, in said Ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, September 23, 1952, at 10 o'clock A. M., in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notices of the proposed street vacation were posted conspicuously along the line of the portion of Olive Street sought to be vacated; and that notices were posted not more than 300 feet apart, and there were more than three (3) of said notices posted,

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1 and said notices were posted at least ten (10) days prior to the
2 date of said hearing; and,

3 WHEREAS, on Tuesday, September 23, 1951, at 10 o'clock A.M.
4 at the place hereinabove designated, a hearing was conducted
5 before the City Council whereat evidence was submitted that said
6 portion of Olive Street described in the ordinance of intention
7 was unnecessary for present or prospective public street purposes.

8 NOW, THE PEOPLE, BE IT ENACTED that the Mayor and Council of
9 the City of Riverside, California, do hereby make order vacat-
10 ing a portion of a street commonly known as Olive Street, as more
11 particularly hereinabove described; that the procedure for the
12 vacation of said portion of Olive Street is being conducted under
13 and by virtue of the authority of law set forth in the Streets and
14 Highways Code of the State of California, Sections 8300 to 8331,
15 inclusive, and cited as the Street Vacation Act of 1941 (Stats.
16 1941, Chapter 250, pages 1357 to 1359, inclusive, and acts
17 amendatory thereto).

18 BE IT FURTHER ENACTED that the City Council does hereby
19 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the
20 reservation of permanent easements and rights of way to construct,
21 maintain, operate, replace, remove and renew sanitary sewers, and
22 storm drains and appurtenant structures in, upon, over and across the
23 portion of the street proposed to be vacated, and reserving to the
24 city the right to construct, maintain, operate, replace, remove,
25 renew and enlarge lines of pipe, conduits, cables, wires, poles
26 and other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the
27 operation of gas pipe lines, telegraphic and telephone lines,
28 railroad lines, and for the transportation or distribution of
29 electric energy, petroleum and its products, ammonia, water, and
30 incidental purposes, including access and the right to keep the
31 property free from inflammable materials, and weed growth, and
32 otherwise protect the same from all hazards in, upon and over the

21 all street maps, and
 22 changes made in
 23 street maps, and
 24 property maps, and
 25 all other papers, maps, and

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1 street or part thereof proposed to be vacated and to take
 2 proceedings for the abandonment of the portion of said street
 3 as hereinafter set forth, subject to such reservations and
 4 exceptions. It is hereby declared the intention of the City
 5 of Riverside that it intends to and does take advantage of all
 6 of the benefits conferred pursuant to Sections 8330 and 8331 of
 7 the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.



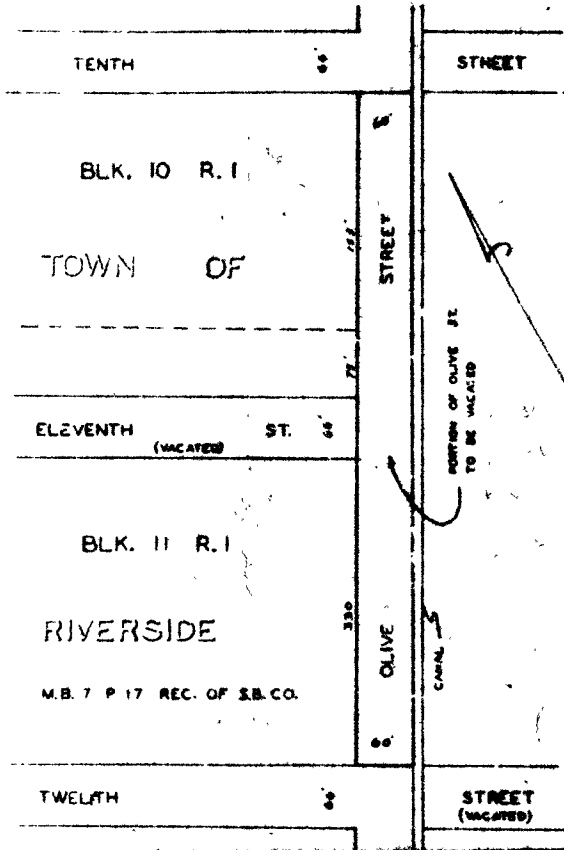
