

RESOLUTION NO. 3170 (NEW SERIES)

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Resolution of the Council of the City of Riverside, California, declaring that the Closing Up and Vacating a portion of Hollister Avenue in said City has been completed.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Riverside, did on the 5th day of April, 1938, pass its Resolution No. 3163 (New Series) ordering the work of closing up and vacating a portion of Hollister Avenue in said City, hereinafter described, as contemplated by Resolution of Intention No. 3155 (New Series) and,

WHEREAS, the Superintendent of Streets of said City has reported that the work of closing up and vacating said portion of Hollister Avenue, has been done and completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Council hereby determines that that portion of Hollister Avenue in said City, hereinafter described, is closed up and vacated.

That portion of Hollister Avenue in said City, hereinabove referred to, is described as follows, to-wit:

All that portion of Hollister Avenue which lies Easterly of the Southerly extension of the Easterly line of Bernard Street, as said streets are shown on Map of Monroe Heights as recorded in Book 15 of Maps, at page 36 thereof, records of Riverside County, California.
