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3 This Indenture made and entered into the 16th day of March,
4 1931 by and between County of Riverside, a body politic and cor-
5 porate of the State of California, party of the first part, and
6 City of Riverside, a municipal corporation of the County of River-
7 side and state of California, party of the second part,

8 WITNESSETH: That for and in consideration of the sum of
9 One (\$1.00) Dollar and other valuable considerations in hand paid
10 by the party of the second part to the party of the first part,
11 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the party of the first
12 part does hereby grant, bargain and sell to the party of the second
13 part, its successors and assigns, all that certain real property
14 situated in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of
15 California and bounded and described as follows:

16 The southwesterly 33 feet of Lot 38 as shown on Map
17 of the Village of Arlington recorded in Book 1 of
18 Maps at page 62 thereof records of the Recorder of
19 San Bernardino County, California, said southwesterly
20 33 feet being a 33 foot strip on the northeasterly
21 side of, parallel with, and adjoining the south-
22 westerly boundary line of said Lot 38 and extending
23 from the southeasterly to the westerly boundary line
24 of said Lot 38, a distance of about 1037.5 feet
25 measured on the southwesterly side thereof. Also the
26 northeasterly 27 feet of Lot 39 as shown on the above
27 described map of the Village of Arlington, said north-
28 easterly 27 feet being a 27 foot strip on the south-
29 westerly side of, parallel with and adjoining the
30 northeasterly boundary line of said Lot 39 and extend-





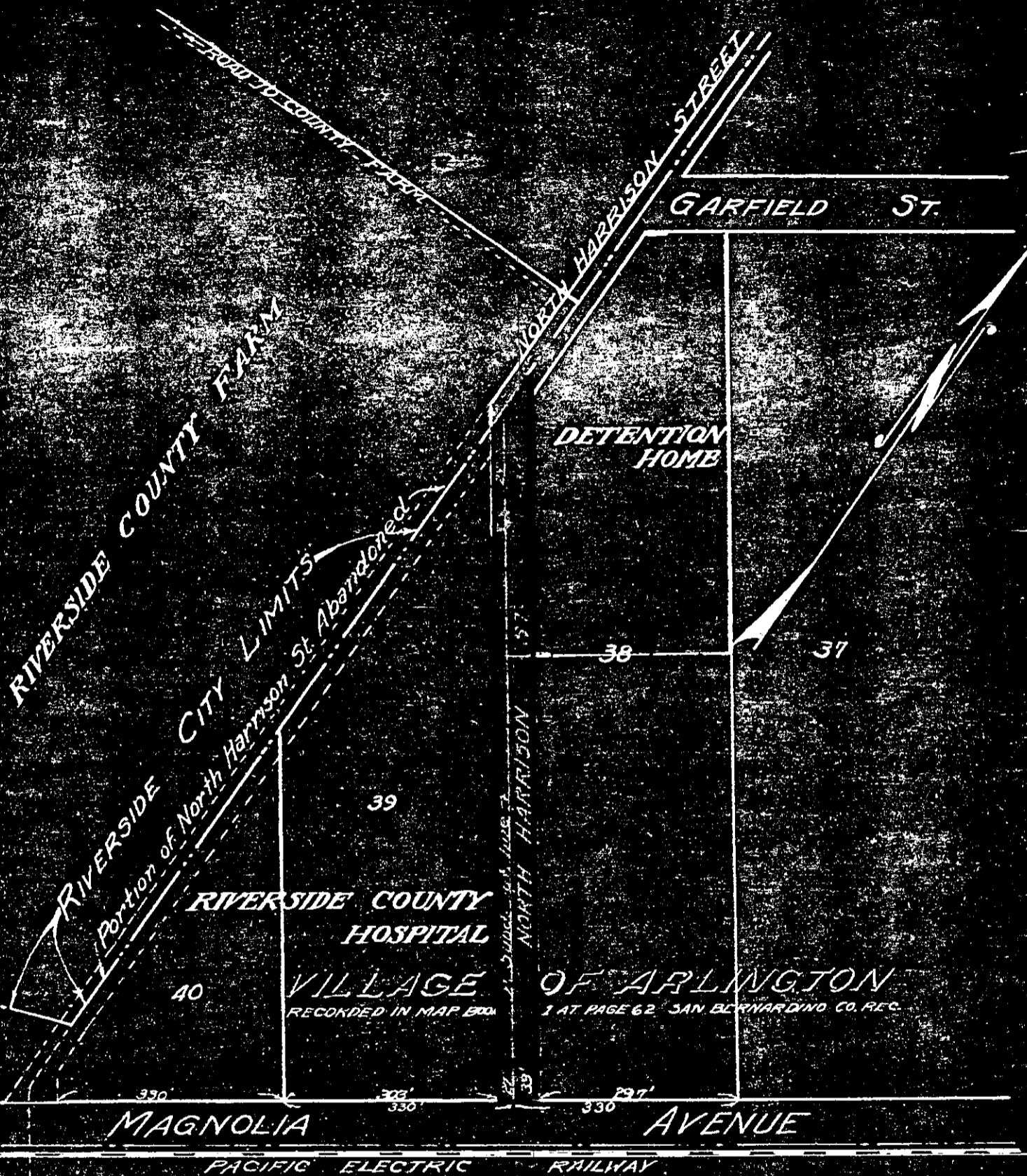
