THIS INDENTURE made and entered into this 15th day of August, 1939, by and between ROSA MAUDE MUNRO , party of the first part, and CITY OF RIVERSIDE, a municipal corporation, party of the second part,

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, said party of the second part wishes to attach one end of a cable to a building known as the Jenkins Building, owned by the said party of the first part and located at the Southerly corner of the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Van Buren Street in said city, for the purpose of suspending a sodium vapor unit light over said intersection; and,

WHEREAS, said party of the first part is willing to give said party of the second part permission and a license to attach one end of said cable to her said building;

NOW, THEREFORE, for a valuable consideration, said party of the first part does hereby give, grant and assign to the said party of the second part a right and easement to attach one end of said cable for such purpose to the said Jenkins Building owned by her and located on the Southerly corner of the intersection of Magnolia Avenue and Van Buren Street in said City of Riverside.

It is Understood and Agreed that the license hereby granted by said party of the first part to the said party of the second part may be revoked upon 90 days notice in writing by said party of the first part to said party of the second part.


