RESOLUTION NO. 3415 (NEW SERIES).

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE,  
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A DEED.

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RESOLVED, that that certain deed dated June 26, 1940, from  
RALVERT & COMPANY, INC., a corporation, granting to the City of  
Riverside, a municipal corporation, an easement and right-of-way,  
thirty (30) feet in width, for the purpose of locating, construct-  
ing, maintaining, operating, repairing, and renewing a conduit for  
water transportation, in, under, over and across that certain parcel  
of land situate in the County of San Bernardino, State of California,  
and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

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Ran Bernardino Co.  
A strip of land thirty feet in width lying 15 feet, measuring  
at right angles, on either side of a line over and across Lot  
4, Block 65, of 160 Acre Survey of Rancho San Bernardino, as  
per map recorded in Book 7 of Maps, at page 2, thereof, Records  
of San Bernardino County, California; said center line being  
described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of said Lot 4; thence North  
0° 19' West 565 feet; thence North 70° 01' 31.56 feet to the  
true point of beginning of said center line across said Lot 4;  
thence North 70° 01' East 1270.76 feet; thence North 9° 57'  
East 121 feet to a point on the Southerly line of the Southern  
Pacific Railroad right-of-way,

be, and the same is hereby, accepted.
