

RESOLUTION NO. 3425 (NEW SERIES)

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A DEED.

*Re-location of Russell St.
Indianapolis Ave (Extended)*

RESOLVED, that that certain deed dated October 3, 1939, from
the PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a California Corporation,
granting to the City of Riverside the right to construct and main-
tain a highway across a certain parcel of land situate in the
City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, de-
scribed as follows, to-wit:

Rec C.

A parcel of land lying within the westerly 40 feet of
that certain 50 foot strip of land second described in
deed from L. V. W. Brown, et al, to the San Bernardino
Inter-Urban Railway Co., Recorded in Book 433, Page 22
of Deeds, Records of Riverside County more particularly
described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the westerly line of the above
mentioned 50 foot strip of land, and distant 277.72 feet
southerly from the center line of Russell Street in the
City of Riverside; said point being the beginning of
a curve concave to the northeast, having a radius of 20
feet; thence southerly along said curve a distance of
31.42 feet; thence easterly and at right angles to the
said westerly line a distance of 20 feet to a line
parallel to and 10 feet (measured at right angles) west-
erly of the easterly line of said 50 foot strip of land;
thence southwesterly along said parallel line a distance
of 66 feet; thence westerly and at right angles to said
parallel line a distance of 20 feet to the beginning of
a curve concave to the southeast, having a radius of 20
feet; thence westerly along said curve a distance of
31.42 feet to a point in the westerly line of said 50
foot strip of land; thence northeasterly along said west-
erly line a distance of 106 feet more or less to the point
of beginning.
