

GRANT DEED

In consideration of One and No/100 -- Dollars,

ALMIRA E. MAKELEY, a widow,

DO HEREBY GRANT TO THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, all that real property situate in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

That portion of lots 1, 2, & 3 of section 29, T. 2 S. R. 5 W., SBEM being 33 feet in width measured at angles to the Jurupa Rancho Boundary, the said Jurupa Rancho Boundary being the northerly line of said 33 foot strip of land; said 33 foot strip of land being bounded on the east by Streeter Avenue and on the West by the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-way.

It is understood that the grantors herein own a portion only of the above described right-of-way and by their signatures convey only that portion owned by each of them.
