

EASEMENT

THIS INDENTURE, made this 26th day of Nov., 1946, by and between

ALEX E. COOMBER and HAZEL E. M. COOMBER, husband and wife,  
parties of the first part,

and

The City of Riverside, party of the second part;

WITNESSETH: . . . . said party of the first part does by these presents grant unto the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, and easement and right of way for the erection and maintenance of poles, electric lines, wires of all descriptions and equipment, overhanging at a minimum distance from the surface of the ground, as specified by the California Railroad Commission, over and across that certain real property situated in the County of Riverside, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

A strip of land of the uniform width of five (5) feet, said strip being two and one-half (2.5) feet each side of the following described center line over and across the following described portion of the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 34, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, San Bernardino Base & Meridian, in the City of Riverside, as shown by US Government Survey;
