

QUITCLAIM

THIS QUITCLAIM made this 19th day of May, 1947, by and between

PEARL PETERSON, et al. PETERSON and DORIS PETERSON

parties of the first part and the City of Riverside a Municipal corporation,  
party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That in consideration of the premises and other valuable considerations,  
receipt of which by the said party of the first part is hereby acknowledged,  
said party of the first part does by these presents remise, release and  
forever quitclaim unto said party of the second part, and its successors and assigns  
forever, all water and water rights located, arising or for use upon, constituting  
a part of or appurtenant to those certain premises, including all public streets,  
alleys and thoroughfares abutting thereon, situate in vicinity of Riverside,  
County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows:

The southwesterly 76 feet of Lots 3 and 4 of Fairview Terrace,  
as shown by Map on file in Book 9 page 54 of Maps, records of  
Riverside County, California.
