14                  erection and maintenance of poles, electric lines, wires of all  
15                  description and equipment, overhanging at a minimum distance from  
16                  the surface of the ground, as specified by the Public Utilities  
17                  Commission, over and across that certain real property situate in  
18                  the County of Riverside, State of California, and more particular-  
19                  ly described as follows: to-wit:

20                  A strip of land over and across the entire Easterly  
21                  twenty (20) feet of the North one-half (1/2) of the  
22                  Northeast one-quarter (1/4) of the Northeast one-  
23                  quarter (1/4) of the Southwest one-quarter (1/4) of  
24                  Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, San  
25                  Bernardino Range and Meridian:

26                  EXCLUDING therefrom, that portion lying within the  
27                  boundaries of Hillside Avenue.

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1 TOGETHER WITH the right of entry upon said premises over and  
2 across which said easement and right-of-way is granted, for the  
3 purpose of installing, maintaining and repairing said poles,  
4 lines, wires and equipment, and to enjoy the use of said easement
