

Deed of Right of Way. 211

Whereas The Board of Trustees of The City of Riverside California desire to lay out and open a street in said City to be known as

extending in an easterly and westerly direction, and the middle of said street to be the dividing line between Lots Two Hundred and four (204) and Two Hundred and Twenty-five (225). Two Hundred and five (205) and Two Hundred and Twenty-four (224). Two Hundred and Six (206) and Two Hundred and Twenty-three (223). Two Hundred and seven (207) and Two Hundred and Twenty-two (222) of the lands formerly owned by the Southern California Colony Association, described according to a survey made by Goldsworthy and Heigle a plat of which is duly recorded in the office of the Recorder of deeds of the County of San Bernardino State of California,

Now therefore, in consideration of the laying out and opening of said street as above described and of the benefits to accrue to us and each of us, thereby, we

That said Street shall never be granted for any railway purposes
This inserted at Mrs Mack before signing

the undersigned, owners, occupants and claimant of land required for such street on the line hereinbefore designated, hereby signify our approval of the laying out and opening of such street, and do hereby consent thereto; and we do hereby grant and dedicate the lands belonging to us and each of us twenty-five (25) feet in width along each side of the middle line of said street, as hereinbefore described, to the said City of Riverside, to that purpose and for the use of such street; and we hereby waive all claims for damage for and on account of the same. 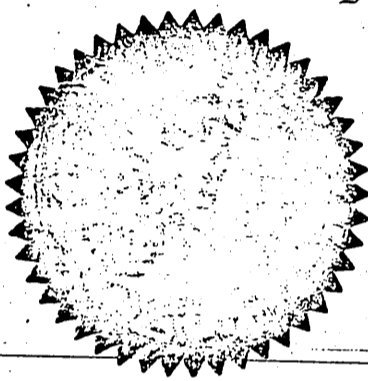

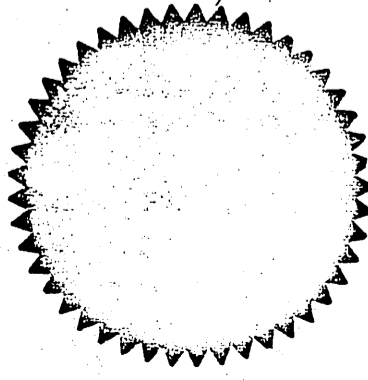
