## RESOLUTION NO. 4933

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING A PORTION OF SCENIC DRIVE DESIGNATED WITHIN THE COUNTRY CLUB PARK SUBDIVISION AS RECORDED IN MAP BOOK 11, PAGE 64, RECORDS OF RIVERSIDE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA.

WHEREAS, there was offered to the City of Riverside, California, a certain street in the "Country Club Park" subdivision and designated within said subdivision map as being Lot B; and,

WHEREAS, said Country Club Park subdivision was accepted by the City of Riverside, California, and thereafter recorded in Map Book 11, page 64, Records of Riverside County, California; and,

WHEREAS, Scenic Drive, designated as Lot B of Country Club Park subdivision, was not accepted by the City of Riverside, California; and

WHEREAS, the property owners adjacent to a portion of said Scenic Drive within the subdivision hereinabove set forth consisting of Houston W. Cage and John C. Carter, and others, did petition the Mayor and Council of said City to accept a portion of said Scenic Drive; and said petitioners did agree to deposit the necessary sums of money for the improvement of the portion of Scenic Drive; and,

WHEREAS, said petitioners have paid into the Street Department the sums necessary for the improvement of a portion of said Scenic Drive.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Riverside, California, does hereby accept the portion of Scenic Drive as hereinafter set forth, designated as Lot B of Country Club Park subdivision, as recorded in Map Book 11, page 64, Records of Riverside County, California; that the portion of the dedicated street which is hereby accepted is located in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and is described as

follows:

Those portions of Lot B of Country Club Park sometimes known as Scenic Drive, a street twenty-five feet (251) in width, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 11, Page 64, Records of Riverside County, California, and described as follows:

That portion of Lot B lying adjacent to and between Lots 1, 4 and 5 on the southeasterly side and Lots 24 and 26 on the northwesterly side; also that portion of Lot B lying adjacent to and between Lots 24 and 26; also that portion of Lot B lying adjacent to and between Lots 23 and 25 and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the most westerly corner of Lot 25; thence northwesterly in a direct line across said Lot B to the southeasterly corner of Lot 23, being a common corner with Lot 24; thence North 44° 29! East along the southeasterly line of said Lot 23 a distance of twenty-three and six-tenths feet (23.6') to an angle point in said southeasterly line; thence southeasterly in a direct line across said Lot B to an angle point in the northwesterly line of Lot 25, said angle point being distant twenty-six and eight-tenths feet (26.8') northeasterly from the most westerly corner of said Lot 25; thence south 44° 29' West along the northwesterly line of said Lot 25 a distance of twenty-six and eight-tenths feet (26.8') to the most westerly corner of said Lot 25, the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a plat is attached to this resolution and is made a part hereof, and that the portion of said Scenic Drive which is hereby accepted is designated upon said plan in red crayon.
