RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, CHANGING THE NAME OF TIBBETTS AVENUE AND TIBBETTS STREET TO TIBBETTS STREET.

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WHEREAS, there is in the City of Riverside a street which is known and designated by the various names of Tibbetts Avenue and Tibbetts Street, said street being between Magnolia Avenue and Brockton Avenue in the Tibbetts Tract, as shown by map recorded in Book 2, page 35 of Maps, Records of San Bernardino County, California, and shown on said map as Eliza Street; and,

WHEREAS, the public convenience requires that said street be known and designated by a single name, and the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside has recommended to the Mayor and Council that the said street be named Tibbetts Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above mentioned street, throughout its entire length, be and the same is hereby named "TIBBETTS STREET."
