WHEREAS, the public convenience requires that said street be known and designated by a single name, and the Planning Commission of the City of Riverside has recommended to the Mayor and Council that the said street be named Marlborough Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the above mentioned street, throughout its entire length, be and the same is hereby named "MARLBOROUGH AVENUE."
