

1 RESOLUTION NO. 5638

2 WHEREAS, on the 27th day of January, 1953, Ordinance No.
3 1851 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring
4 the intention of the City Council to vacate the public utility ease-
5 ments in Lot E of Jones Tract pursuant to the provisions of the
6 Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

7 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for
8 Tuesday, March 10, 1953, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council
9 Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets,
10 Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons
11 interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed
12 to be heard; and,

13 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section
14 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

15 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before
16 said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time
17 the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legis-
18 lative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence
19 submitted that the public utility easements which the legislative
20 body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present
21 or prospective public use.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Mayor and Council of the
23 City of Riverside, California, that the public utility easements
24 on Lot E of Jones Tract, in the City of Riverside, County of River-
25 side, State of California, and described as follows:

26 Parcel 1:

27 The northerly eighteen and thirty hundredths feet (18.30')
28 of the easterly ninety-seven feet (97') of Lot E, Jones
29 Tract, as shown on map recorded in Map Book 24, at page 35,
30 Records of Riverside County, California;

31 Parcel 2:

32 The northerly eighteen and thirty hundredths feet (18.30')
of the Westerly eight feet (8') of Lot E, Jones Tract,
as shown on map recorded in Map Book 24, at page 35, Records
of Riverside County, California;

Parcel 3:

The southerly nine and seventy hundredths feet (9.70') of
the easterly ninety-seven feet (97') of Lot E, Jones Tract,
as shown on map recorded in Map Book 24, at page 35, Records
of Riverside County, California;

are unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same
be and are hereby vacated.

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the public utility easements which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the public utility easements on Lot E of Jones Tract, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

Parcel 1:

The northerly eighteen and thirty hundredths feet (18.30') of the easterly ninety-seven feet (97') of Lot E, Jones Tract, as shown on map recorded in Map Book 24, at page 35, Records of Riverside County, California;

Parcel 2:

The northerly eighteen and thirty hundredths feet (18.30') of the westerly eight feet (8') of Lot E, Jones Tract, as shown on map recorded in Map Book 24, at page 35, Records of Riverside County, California;

Parcel 3:

The southerly nine and seventy hundredths feet (9.70') of the easterly ninety-seven feet (97') of Lot E, Jones Tract, as shown on map recorded in Map Book 24, at page 35, Records of Riverside County, California;

are unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same be and are hereby vacated.
