

1 RESOLUTION NO. 5664

2 RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING THE
4 PUBLIC UTILITY EASEMENT OVER A PORTION OF LOT 36, EL
5 MOLINO TRACT NO. 4.

6 WHEREAS, on the 10th day of February, 1953, Ordinance No. 1859
7 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the
8 intention of the City Council to vacate a public utility easement
9 over a portion of Lot 36, El Molino Tract No. 4, pursuant to the
10 provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

11 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for
12 Tuesday, March 17, 1953, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers
13 located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside,
14 California, at which said time and place all persons interested in
15 or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

16 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section
17 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California, and,

18 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had
19 before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which
20 time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the
21 legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the
22 evidence submitted that the public utility easement which the
23 legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unnecessary
24 for present or prospective public use.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the Mayor and Council of the
26 City of Riverside, California, that the public utility easement
27 over a portion of Lot 36, El Molino Tract No. 4 in the City of
28 Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described
29 as follows:

30 The southerly eighty-six and thirty hundredths feet
31 (86.30') of the westerly ten feet (10') of Lot 36, El
32 Molino Tract No. 4, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 25,
at page 39, Records of Riverside County, California;

is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same be
and is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy of
this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the
office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

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
