RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE NO. 1931; AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF MAKING A PUBLIC STREET/

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WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, adopted an ordinance of intention No. 1931, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, declaring its intention to vacate a portion of a street commonly known as Streeter Avenue in Grand Avenue Tract and,

NOW, WHEREAS, it is RESOLVED by the City Council that it be and is hereby found and determined by said City Council that said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceedings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting, as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said portion of the public street therein described is unnecessary for present or prospective public purposes and should be vacated.

NOW, WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941 it is hereby ordered by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of Streeter Avenue in Grand Avenue Tract, _____, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows, to-wit

All that portion of Streeter Avenue lying north of Jupa Avenue, as shown on map of Grand Avenue Tract, recorded July 13, 1909, in Book 6 of Maps, page 77, Records of Riverside County, California;

be, and the same is hereby, vacated without reserving any easements or rights therein.
