RESOLUTION NO. 5909

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, CONCERNING THE VACATING OF PORTIONS OF THE BRUSCA AND GRANADA TRACTS IN BRUSCA TRACT AND GRANADA TRACT.

WHEREAS, on the 4th day of August, 1953, Ordinance No. 1943 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate portions of the pedestrian walks Brusca and Granada Tracts pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, September 22, 1953, at 10 o'clock A.M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the portions of the pedestrian walks which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate are unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions of the pedestrian walks in Brusca and Granada Tracts, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

The western five feet (5') of Lots E and G of the BRUSCA TRACT, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 23, at Page 18, Records of Riverside County, California.

Also

The western five feet (5') of Lots C and D of the GRANADA TRACT, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 21, at Page 5, Records of Riverside County,

are unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same be and are hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
