

RESOLUTION No. 6048

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS SEWER MAINS AND PUBLIC SERVICE EASEMENT IN GRADA TRACT No. 2, GRADA TRACT No. 2.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of October, 1953, Ordinance No. 1003 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate a public service easement in Grada Tract No. 2, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, December 1, 1953, at 10 o'clock A.M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of vacation was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found that all of the evidence submitted that the public service easement for sewer and drainage purposes which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, HAS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the public service easement in Grada Tract No. 2, in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

All of Lot G, Grada Tract No. 2, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 24 at page 71, Merced County, California, containing a public utility easement across said Lot G, fifteen feet (15') in width, the north end, part of which is a constant one hundred forty-five feet (145') southerly from and parallel to the east line of said Lot G,

is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same be and is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy of this order, attested by his hand and seal, to be kept in the office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

3 WHEREAS, on the 6th day of October, 1953, Ordinance No. 1983
4 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the
5 intention of the City Council to vacate a public service easement
in Granada Tract No. 2, pursuant to the provisions of the Public
Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

6 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for
7 Tuesday, December 1, 1953, at 10 o'clock A.M. in the Council
8 Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets,
Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons
interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed
to be heard; and,

9 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Sec-
10 tion 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

11 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had
12 before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at
13 which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard
14 by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all
15 of the evidence submitted that the public service easement for
sewer and drainage purposes which the legislative body declared
its intention to vacate is unnecessary for present or prospective
public use.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the
17 City of Riverside, California, that the public service easement
in Granada Tract No. 2, in the City of Riverside, County of River-
side, State of California, and described as follows:

18 All of Lot G, Granada Tract No. 2, as shown on a map
19 recorded in Map Book 24 at page 98, Records of Riverside
20 County, RESERVING a public utility easement across said
21 Lot G, fifteen feet (15') in width, the northerly line of
which is distant one hundred forty-five feet (145') southerly
from and parallel to the northerly end of said Lot G,

22 is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same
be and is hereby vacated.

23 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy of
24 this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the Office
of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

25 ADOPTED by the City Council, signed by the Mayor, and attested
26 by the City Clerk this 1st day of December, 1953.
