NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941, BE IT ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portion of Short Street in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows, to wit:

All that portion of the northeast one-quarter of Section 32, Township 2 South, Range 5 West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, as described in a deed to the City of Riverside recorded May 6, 1930 in Book 112, at Page 307 of Deeds, Records of Riverside County, as being a strip of land fifty feet (50') in width commencing from the easterly line of the northeast quarter of Section 32, and running thence westerly through the middle of said quarter section, a distance of forty rods (40 rods); INCLUDING THEREON the easterly forty-one feet (41') thereof;

is, and the same is hereby vacated without reserving any easements or rights therein.
