2 RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
3 RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING
4 A PUBLIC SERVICE EASEMENT, BEING LOT G, GRANADA
5 TRACT NO. 2.

6 WHEREAS, on the 22nd day of December, 1953, Ordinance No. 2012
7 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the
8 intention of the City Council to vacate a public service easement
9 in Granada Tract No. 2, pursuant to the provisions of the Public
10 Service Easements Vacation Law; and,

11 WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for
12 Tuesday, February 16, 1954, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council
13 Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets,
14 Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons
15 interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed
16 to be heard; and,

17 WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section
18 50441 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

19 WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had
20 before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at
21 which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard
22 by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all
23 of the evidence submitted that the public service easement for
24 sewer and drainage purposes which the legislative body declared
25 its intention to vacate is unnecessary for present or prospective
26 public use.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the
28 City of Riverside, California, that the public service easement
29 in Granada Tract No. 2, in the City of Riverside, County of
30 Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

31 All of Lot G, Granada Tract No. 2, as shown
32 on a map recorded in Map Book 24 at page 98,
Records of Riverside County, RESERVING a public
utility easement across said Lot G, fifteen
feet (15') in width, the northerly line of which

is distant one hundred forty-five feet (145') southerly from and parallel to the northerly end of said Lot G,

is unnecessary for present or prospective use, and that the same be and is hereby vacated.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk cause a certified copy of this order, attested by him under seal, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.

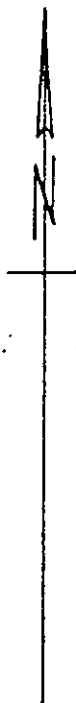

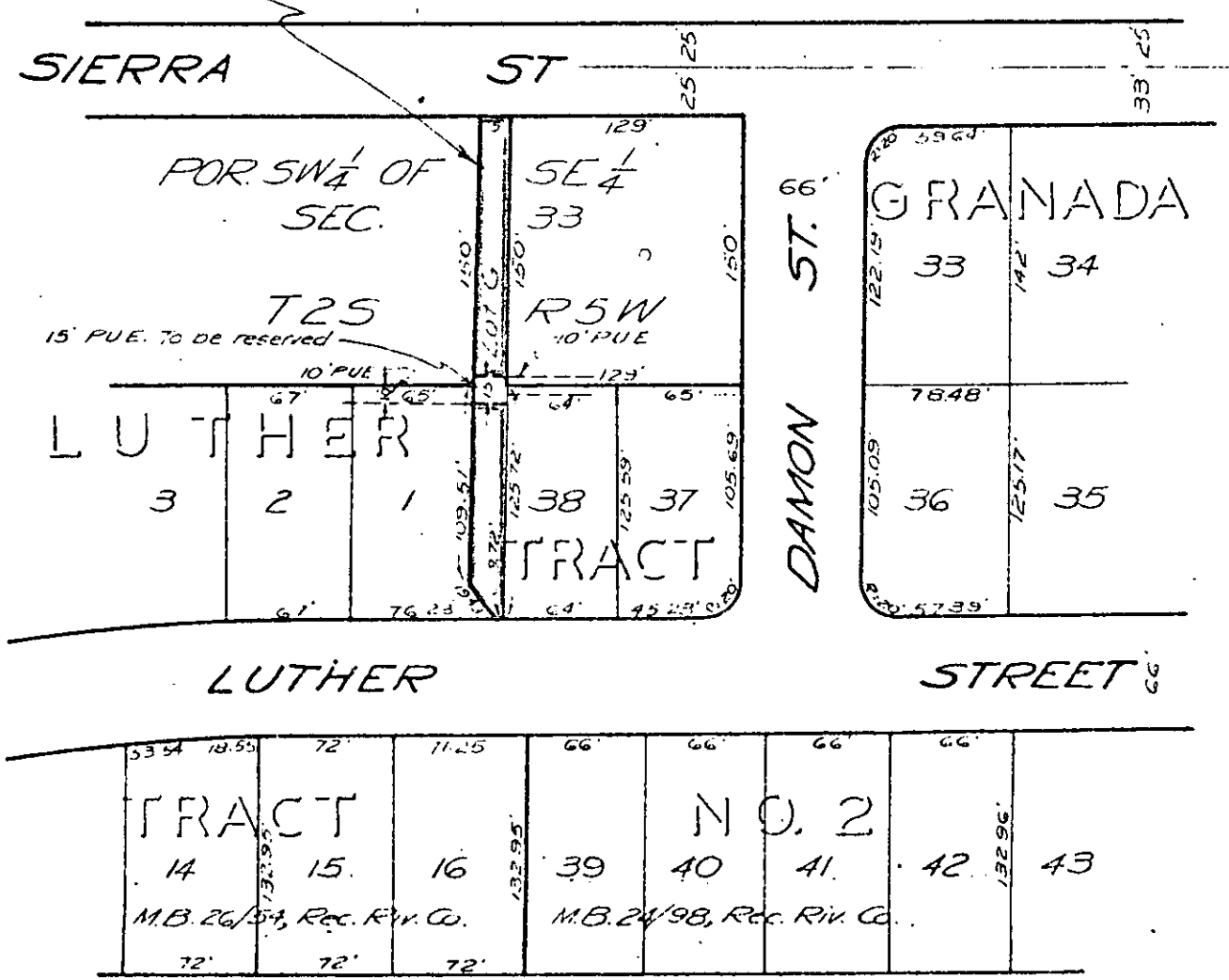
