

RESOLUTION NO. 6342

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE OF INTENTION NO. 2101; RESERVING EASEMENTS AND RIGHTS OF WAY; AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING PORTIONS OF ELSINORE ROAD.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, adopted an ordinance of intention, No. 2101, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, declaring its intention to vacate portions of Elsinore Road, therein and hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the matter came on regularly for hearing before said City Council at the time and place fixed for hearing by said ordinance of intention, and said City Council heard and considered all of the evidence submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said City Council that it be and is hereby found and determined by said City Council that said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceedings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting, as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said portions of the public street therein described are unnecessary for present or prospective public purposes and should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions of Elsinore Road in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows, to wit:

Parcel 1

A portion of Elsinore Road, shown on a map of Victoria Ranch, recorded in Map Book 4, at Page 59, Records of Riverside County, described as follows:

1 Commencing at a point in the center line of
 2 Elsinore Road, said point being on the south line
 3 of Lot 11, of said Victoria Ranch, and bears South
 4 $89^{\circ} 03'$ West a distance of twenty-four hundred
 5 twenty-two and two hundredths feet (2422.02') from
 6 the southeast corner of Lot 9 of said Victoria
 7 Ranch; thence South $00^{\circ} 57'$ East a distance of
 8 twenty-five feet (25') to a point on the southerly
 9 right of way line of said Elsinore Road; thence South
 10 $89^{\circ} 03'$ West along the southerly line of said Elsinore
 11 Road, a distance of sixty-two and eighty-one hundredths
 12 feet (62.81') to the true point of beginning of this
 13 description; thence continuing South $89^{\circ} 03'$ West along
 14 the southerly line of said Elsinore Road a distance
 15 of one hundred one and sixty-eight hundredths feet
 16 (101.68'); thence North $25^{\circ} 02' 48''$ East a distance
 17 of nine and seventy-seven hundredths feet (9.77');
 18 thence along a curve concave to the southeast, having
 19 a radius of twenty feet (20') and a central angle of
 20 $83^{\circ} 56' 37''$, an arc length of twenty-nine and thirty
 21 hundredths feet (29.30'); thence along a curve concave
 22 to the northeast having a radius of three hundred
 23 ninety-seven feet (397') and a central angle of
 24 $10^{\circ} 50' 15''$ an arc length of seventy-five and nine
 25 hundredths feet (75.09') to the true point of
 26 beginning of this description; a radial line to said
 27 curve at said point bearing North $8^{\circ} 09' 10''$ East.

15 Parcel 2

16 Commencing at the true point of beginning of the
 17 description for Parcel 1; thence South $89^{\circ} 03'$ West
 18 along the southerly line of Elsinore Road a distance
 19 of one hundred sixty-eight and forty-three hundredths
 20 feet (168.43') to the true point of beginning of this
 21 description.
 22 Thence North $25^{\circ} 02' 48''$ East a distance of thirty-
 23 nine and ninety-three hundredths feet (39.93'); thence
 24 along a curve concave to the southwest having a radius
 25 of twenty feet (20') to its intersection with the
 26 northerly right of way line of said Elsinore Road (50
 27 feet in width); thence South $89^{\circ} 03'$ West along the
 28 said northerly line of Elsinore Road to its intersec-
 29 tion with the southeasterly line of Victoria Avenue,
 30 said point being on a curve in said southeasterly line,
 31 a radial line at said point bearing South $41^{\circ} 49' 20''$
 32 East; thence along said curve in the southeasterly line
 of Victoria Avenue, being concave to the southeast and
 having a radius of two hundred eighty-nine and sixty-
 two hundredths feet (289.62') and a central angle of
 $13^{\circ} 25' 40''$, an arc length of sixty-seven and eighty-
 eight hundredths feet (67.88') to its intersection with
 the southerly right of way line of Elsinore Road;
 thence North $89^{\circ} 03'$ East along said southerly line
 a distance of four hundred five and fifty-four hundredths
 feet (405.54') to the true point of beginning;

30 be, and the same are hereby, vacated.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council does hereby
 32 determine that the public convenience and necessity require the

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1 reservations of easements and rights of way to maintain, operate,
2 repair, and eventually remove conduits, cables, wires, poles, and
3 other convenient structures, equipment and fixtures for the opera-
4 tion of telegraphic and telephone lines and for the transportation
5 or distribution of electric energy and incidental purposes, and to
6 take proceedings for the abandonment of the portions of said
7 street as hereinabove set forth, subject to such reservations and
8 exceptions.

9 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of
10 Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested
11 by the Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the
12 office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.
