RESOLUTION NO. 6371

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE OF INTENTION NO. 2087, RESERVING EASEMENTS FOR WATER, ELECTRIC AND COMMUNICATIONS LINES, AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING PORTIONS OF AN UNIMBED EASEMENT FOR STREET PURPOSES IN WHITE'S ADDITION AND SANTA FE TRACT.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, adopted an ordinance of intention, No. 2087, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, declaring its intention to vacate portions of an unimbed easement for street purposes in White's Addition and Santa Fe Tract, therein and hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the matter came on regularly for hearing before said City Council at the time and place fixed for hearing by said ordinance of intention, and said City Council heard and considered all of the evidence submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said City Council that it be and is hereby found and determined by said City Council that said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceedings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting, as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said portions of the unimbed easement for street purposes therein described are unnecessary for present or prospective public purposes, and should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the portions of the unimbed easement for street purposes in the City of Riverside, County


