RESOLUTION NO. 6393

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RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS IN THE MATTER OF ORDINANCE OF INTENTION NO. 2112; AND ORDER OF VACATION IN THE MATTER OF VACATING WADSWORTH AVENUE AND AN UNNAMED STREET IN SANDERSON'S SUBDIVISION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, adopted an ordinance of intention, No. 2112, pursuant to the provisions of the Street Vacation Act of 1941, being Part 3, Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, declaring its intention to vacate Wadsworth Avenue and an unnamed street in Sanderson's Subdivision, therein and hereinafter described; and,

WHEREAS, the matter came on regularly for hearing before said City Council at the time and place fixed for hearing by said ordinance of intention, and said City Council heard and considered all of the evidence submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said City Council that it be and is hereby found and determined by said City Council that said ordinance of intention was duly passed, adopted and published in the manner prescribed by law for the adopting and publishing of ordinances of said City, and the notice of said vacation proceedings and of the time and place of hearing was given by posting, as provided by the Street Vacation Act of 1941, and that the said Wadsworth Avenue and the unnamed street in Sanderson's Subdivision therein described are unnecessary for present or prospective public purposes and should be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of the said Street Vacation Act of 1941, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that Wadsworth Avenue and the unnamed street in Sanderson's Subdivision in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, described as follows, to wit:

1 All of Wadsworth Avenue and all of the unnamed  
2 street adjacent to the east lines of lots 1 and  
3 24, all as shown on map of Sanderson's Subdivision  
4 recorded in Map Book 5, at page 70, Records of San  
5 Bernardino County, California;


6 be, and the same are hereby vacated.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the City Clerk of said City of  
8 Riverside shall cause a certified copy of this order, attested  
9 by the Clerk under the seal of said City, to be recorded in the  
10 office of the County Recorder of Riverside County, California.


