RESOLUTION NO. 6488

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RIVERSIDE, CALIFORNIA, MAKING ITS ORDER VACATING PEDESTRIAN WALK IN MAGNOLIA VILLAGE TRACT.

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of November, 1954, Ordinance No. 2128 of the City of Riverside, California, was adopted, declaring the intention of the City Council to vacate a pedestrian walk in Magnolia Village Tract, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Service Assessments Vacation Law; and,

WHEREAS, in said ordinance the time of hearing was set for Tuesday, December 28, 1954, at 10 o'clock A. M. in the Council Chambers located in the City Hall, Seventh and Orange Streets, Riverside, California, at which said time and place all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed vacation be allowed to be heard; and,

WHEREAS, notice of hearing was given as provided by Section 50331 of the Government Code of the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, a hearing of the ordinance of intention was had before said legislative body at the time and place fixed, at which time the evidence offered by persons interested was heard by the legislative body; and the legislative body found from all of the evidence submitted that the pedestrian walk which the legislative body declared its intention to vacate is unnecessary for present or prospective public use.


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED by the City Council of the City of Riverside, California, that the pedestrian walk in Magnolia Village Tract in the City of Riverside, County of Riverside, State of California, and described as follows:

All of Lot C of Magnolia Village Tract, as shown on a map recorded in Map Book 23, at Page 72, Records of Riverside County, reserving the southerly ten feet (10') thereof for a Public Utility Easement;


is unnecessary for present or prospective public use, and that the same be and is hereby vacated.
